OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

We have the chance to bless children in need around the world. What do you need to do to participate? See Below!

Get A Box: Start with an average-size cardboard or plastic shoebox. If you want to wrap it, cover the box and lid separately.

Girl or Boy: Decide whether you will pack a box for a girl or a boy, and the age category: 2-4, 5-9, or 10-14

Pray: Most importantly, pray for the child who will receive your gift. You can also include a personal note and photo.

Brand New Batons: Put your initials on the ball (very small) with a ball point pen. If they need taped please see Miss Loretta.

<u>Used Batons:</u> If you have an older baton and the tape needs rewrapped please take off all the tape and residue (Goo Gone is perfect for that) on the baton and give it to Miss Loretta to tape. Clean the tips and put your initials on the ball.

Caps must be stretched and worked to fit over the tips. DO NOT WEAR THE CAPS FOR PERFORMANCES!!
